## Altman Summer Scholar Internship Program Student Application Summer 2015

Miami's Entrepreneurship program aims to train the startup workforce through real-world, challenging and immersive experiences. The Altman Summer Scholar Internship is a unique program designed to give Miami students a chance to make a significant impact with a start-up or entrepreneurial business. This summer internship program is made possible through the generous financial support of Miami alumnus John W. Altman ('60), the founding Director of Miami's Entrepreneurship program.

### Overview

Each summer, Altman Scholars have the opportunity to work take a deep dive into what it takes to work for a successful entrepreneurial company. Altman Scholars will be expected to make a significant impact in the business and in the entrepreneurial community. The Altman Summer Scholar Internship Program is a full-time paid internship and start-up course focused on developing your professional skill set, and making a difference in your host company. Each intern works directly with the team, and in some cases, with the founders and executive leadership team.

### **Cohort Program**

Students selected as Altman Scholars will participate in the following:

- Full-time paid internship with your specific host company
- Weekly Cohort Meetups with cohort members at various entrepreneurial locations in the region
- ESP 490: Startup Entrepreneurship in Chicago/Cincinnati
  - o 3 credit summer course
- Altman Summer Showcase
  - o Final Portfolio and Presentation to the entire entrepreneurial community

#### Requirements for the Altman Scholar Program

- Current Freshman, Sophomore or Junior standing with an interest in entrepreneurship
- At least a 2.25 GPA
- Meet the minimum qualifications outlined by the host company
- Enroll in ESP 490 workshop (Summer 2015)
  - Enrollment will take place AFTER the selection process (you do not need to be registered previous to applying)
- Attend pre-internship workshop kick-off with Founding Director, John Altman
  - o April 30<sup>th</sup> (6:00pm) at Miami University

### What it Takes

Entrepreneurial companies recruit rock stars. People who want to work hard, learn fast, and be a great team member are ideal candidates for Altman Summer Scholar Interns.

That doesn't mean you have to have a huge amount of work experience; it means you have to:

- Be coachable
- Take risks
- Work above and beyond expectations
- Not take yourself too seriously, but take your work seriously
- Be willing to thrive in ambiguity

### **How it Works**

  - Go to the section "Application" and download the 2015 Host Company Project Information.
- Application Deadline: Submit your application no later than 5pm, Monday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2015.
  - Pay attention to:
    - Each company's location! The company and the Institute ARE NOT responsible for travel or living expenses during the internship.
    - Each company's application requirements...some will require you to complete their application online, others a video, etc.
    - If you do contact the company in advance of them receiving your application, be sure to indicate you are applying through Miami's Entrepreneurship Intern Program as well.
- Application Instructions:

- **Company Interviews:** The companies will receive your application materials and will contact you ONLY if they would like to continue the interview process with you.
  - o All host companies will be matched with interns on or around April 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Altman Cohort Pre-Internship Workshop: April 30<sup>th</sup> at 6pm and TBD Workshop Day.
- Internship Start Date: Internships will begin on or around May 19<sup>th</sup> (pending the host company arrangement) and conclude in August (pending the host company arrangement). Each intern must sign a host company agreement form outlining the intern expectations throughout their internship.
- Altman Showcase: The final presentations will be conducted in the location of your internship.
